Minutes of the 65th State Level Single Window Clearance Authority (SLSWCA) meeting held on 29/09/2016 at 12.15P.M. in the 2nd floor Conference hall of Odisha Secretariat.

The meeting was chaired by the Chief Secretary, Odisha. The list of members present is annexed.

CMD, IPICOL welcomed the chairperson & other participants and proceeded with the agenda.

AGENDA ITEM No.1: Confirmation of the minutes of 64thSLSWCA meeting held on 26/07/2016.

Minutes of the 64th SLSWCA meeting held on26/07/2016 were confirmed.

AGENDA ITEM No.2: Action taken report on the 64th SLSWCA meeting.

SLSWCA noted the action taken on various items.

AGENDA ITEM NO: 3

Proposal of M/s IFFCO (Indian Farmers Fertiliser Cooperative Ltd.) to develop a Private Railway siding at village Bhitaragarh, Paradeep at New Paradeep Station Yard under Khurda Road Division of East Coast Railway in Odisha with a total investment of Rs.63.55 crores.

After detailed discussions, SLSWCA in-principle approved the proposal of the company subject to the following terms and conditions:

a) The project should not be located on mineral bearing area or command area of any irrigation project.

b) The company will submit detail land use plan. Allotment of land to the project is subject to assessment by IPICOL (considering the bench mark report where ever

- available) or as required by the company, whichever is lower. The company will follow the prescribed procedure of IDCO for final allotment.
- c) The company has to obtain all statutory clearances as may be required and abide by the conditions/ stipulations made by statutory bodies of Govt. of India / Govt. of Odisha.
- d) The company shall strictly comply with the State Employment norms, R&R Policy and other policies of Govt. as applicable from time to time.
- e) The company must take-up CSR activities in the locality in consultation with the District Collector. Besides, the company shall comply with the extant rules and policy issued by Govt. of India / Govt. of Odisha from time to time.
- f) The promoter(s) of the company shall not divest/dilute either directly or indirectly their share holding to less than 51% till 3 years from the date of commencement of commercial operation without the prior approval of the Govt.
- g) The company wil submit its action plan for implementation of the proposed projectl to IPICOL within 90 days of the communication of approval of SLSWCA.
- h) Use of flyash bricks is mandatory for all the construction that will be taken up.
- Rain water harvesting and ground water recharging is mandatory for industrial establishment.
- j) Company to generate 5% of its power requirement through renewable energy sources.

Proposal of M/s Welspun Orissa Steel Pvt. Ltd. to set up a 0.27MTPA long product(Steel) facilities centre at Dosingha, near Dhamra, Dist. Bhadrak with an investment of Rs. 160.15 crores.

After detailed discussions, SLSWCA in-principle approved the proposal of the company subject to the following terms and conditions:

- a) The company will set up a Textile Unit at Bhadrak textile park in addition to the long product (Steel) facilities centre at Dhamra.
- b) No raw material linkage/assurance shall be committed by the State Government for the said project.
- c) The company has to submit proposed detailed land use plan and the land requirement for the project which is subject to the assessment by IPICOL or as per the requirement submitted by the company whichever is less.
- d) The project should not be located on mineral bearing area or command area of any irrigation project.
- e) Requirement of water is subject to assessment by IPICOL and approval of Water Resource Department. The company is required to arrange water storage facility



- at its own cost in their own land area, if required as per the stipulation/condition of WRD.
- f) The company has to obtain all statutory clearances as may be required before start of the land acquisition process and abide by the conditions/stipulations made by statutory bodies of Govt of India/Govt of Odisha.
- g) The company shall strictly comply with the State employment norms, R & R Policy and other policies of Govt. as applicable from time to time.
- h) The company must take up CSR activities in the locality in consultation with the District Collector. Besides, the company shall comply with the extant rules and policy issued by Govt. from time to time.
- i) The project shall not be located within 500 meters from the centre of the road on both sides of any NH or SH or from the bank of any river/reservoir.
- j) The company should make adequate provisions for parking of the transport vehicles required for their operations to ensure that project related vehicles are not parked within 200 meters from any NH/SH.
- k) The promoter(s) of the company shall not divest/dilute either directly or indirectly their share holding to less than 51% till 3 years from the date of commencement of commercial operation without the prior approval of the Govt.
- I) The company wil submit its action plan for implementation of the proposed project to IPICOL within 90 days of the communication of approval of SLSWCA.
- m) Use of flyash bricks is mandatory for all the construction that the company may take up.
- n) Rain water harvesting and ground water recharging is mandatory for industrial establishment.
- company to generate 5% of its power requirement through renewable energy sources.

Proposal of M/s. Shree Cement Ltd. (SCL) for change of location from village Mohanpur, Tehsil Odapada, Dhenkanal to village Chandrabali Shyampur, Tehsil Athagarh, Cuttack for the proposed 3 Million Tonnes per Annum (MTPA) Cement grinding unit with an investment of Rs.452.55 Crores.

After detailed discussions, SLSWCA noted the change of location of the company with the same terms & conditions as decided in the 49th SLSWCA meeting held on 05.11.2014.

Report on Land Assessment of M/s Jindal Steel & Power Ltd. (JSPL), Angul

The report on additional land assessment of M/s Jindal Steel & Power Ltd., (JSPL), Angul was discussed and clarifications given by the representative of M/s. Engineers India Ltd on the layout drawings was accepted by the SLSWCA.

Additional land of 370.23 Acre, as assessed by EIL, over the earlier assessment of 4507.59 Acre, totalling 4877.82 Acre was approved by the SLSWCA subject to the condition that no additional land will be considered at a later stage.

After detailed discussions, SLSWCA noted the investment intentions received during 'Make in India' Week in Mumbai and Odisha Investors' Meet in Bengaluru and made the following observations:



- 1. Renewable energy policy and Textiles and Apparel policies by Energy and Textile and Handloom Depts respectively may be notified by Oct 31 2016.
- 2. Tourism Dept. to discuss with M/s Royal Orchid Hotel and to ensure the submission of the hotel proposal.
- 3. Tata group may be advised to come for discussion along with timelines on the development of the proposed Taj Hotel at Bhubaneswar and Industrial Estate at Naraj.
- 5. The issue of boundary wall and encroachment on HAL land at Sunabeda, Koraput to be resolved on top priority by CMD IDCO.
- 6.The SLSWCA decided to assign the proposals to Nodal Departments for necessary follow up. The same is placed at Annexure A.
